Also, FAR 28.302 requires that the certificate read as follows: "Should any of the above described policies be cancelled or materially changed before the expiration date thereto, the issuing company will mail thirty (30) days written notice to the certificate holder named to the left".

Any work performed prior to Notice to Proceed will be at your own risk.
